3 RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS IN ITS
4 ADOPTION OF URGENCY ORDINANCE 3071 AND SUBSEQUENT ADOPTION OF A
5 COMPREHENSIVE CANNABIS CULTIVATION ORDINANCE

6 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake has engaged in a series of
7 Board meetings and workshops designed to culminate in the adoption of a cannabis cultivation
8 ordinance; and

9 WHEREAS, on December 19, 2017, the Lake County Board of Supervisors adopted an
10 Urgency Ordinance which was extended on January 23, 2018 (Lake County Ordinance No. 3071),
11 which established a moratorium against the cultivation, distribution, transport, storage, manufacturing,
12 processing, testing, and sale of commercial cannabis in any unincorporated area of the County during
13 that period of time while the County worked to complete a cannabis cultivation ordinance; and

14 WHEREAS, the moratorium so imposed was made subject to an express allowance that during
15 the time it remained in effect and until a permanent ordinance for cannabis cultivation was made final,
16 those persons who (1) have submitted a self-certification under Article 72 of the Zoning Ordinance
17 which has been deemed complete by the Community Development Department and (2) have submitted
18 a signed affidavit of compliance with state law and the conditions of the Urgency Ordinance would be
19 issued a Letter of Authorization to proceed with applications for temporary state licensure as therein
20 specified; and

21 WHEREAS, the County has made CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing aware of the County's
22 Urgency Ordinance and the intent of this Board that applicants for temporary state licensure remain
23 eligible to continue through the state licensing process while the County finalizes and adopts a cannabis
24 cultivation ordinance; and

25 WHEREAS, on this date, March 20, 201, the Board of Supervisors has adopted such an
26 ordinance, establishing a comprehensive regulatory framework for the cultivation of cannabis in the
27 unincorporated areas of the County, which will be (30) days hence; and

28 WHEREAS, through this resolution, this Board wishes to express its intent that the County's
Urgency Ordinance be viewed as a means to ensure that those persons applying to CalCannabis

Cultivation Licensing for temporary cannabis cultivation licenses, who are in compliance with requirements of the Urgency Ordinance remain eligible for and active in the State process to obtain temporary State cultivation licenses; and

WHEREAS, this Board further wishes to express that, with its passage of the County's permanent cannabis cultivation ordinance on this date, it intends that persons eligible for temporary state licenses for cultivation of the nature and type permitted by the County's permanent cultivation ordinance will be permitted by the County, subject to all terms and conditions of the permanent ordinance when the County ordinance becomes effective.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. This Board hereby adopts the above recitals as true and correct.
2. In light of the passage of the County's comprehensive cannabis cultivation ordinance, this Board hereby requests that CalCannabis Cultivation Licensing take no action in the next thirty days to reject any County of Lake license applications solely on the basis that said ordinance is not yet operative and instead, that it review those applications in anticipation of the upcoming effective date of the County's ordinance.
