WHEREAS, Article 10 of the California Emergency Services Act (California Government Code, Section 8610) mandates that Operational Areas develop plans for meeting any condition constituting a local emergency or state of emergency, including, but not limited to, earthquakes, natural or manmade disasters specific to that jurisdiction, or state of war emergency, which minimize injury, loss of life and damage caused by a major emergency or disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services is the identified disaster agency for the County and is responsible for the planning and coordination of the local disaster services; and

WHEREAS, the existing 1996 Lake County Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP") has become dated and does not meet the requirements of the National Incident Management System and the Standardized Emergency Management System; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services, in conjunction with the offices, departments, municipal agencies and other key partners in the Operational Area, has developed an updated EOP for the County of Lake and the Lake County Operational Area, and said plan has been made available to the public and all concerned agencies for review and comment; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Disaster Council was convened on December 13, 2017, and approved by motion a recommendation to forward the proposed EOP to the Board of
