3 **RESOLUTION ADOPTING EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN**
4 **FOR THE COUNTY OF LAKE AND THE LAKE COUNTY OPERATIONAL AREA**

6 WHEREAS, Article 10 of the California Emergency Services Act (California
7 Government Code, Section 8610) mandates that Operational Areas develop plans for meeting
8 any condition constituting a local emergency or state of emergency, including, but not limited to,
9 earthquakes, natural or manmade disasters specific to that jurisdiction, or state of war
10 emergency, which minimize injury, loss of life and damage caused by a major emergency or
11 disaster; and

12 WHEREAS, the Lake County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services is the identified
13 disaster agency for the County and is responsible for the planning and coordination of the local
14 disaster services; and

15 WHEREAS, the existing 1996 Lake County Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP") has
16 become dated and does not meet the requirements of the National Incident Management System
17 and the Standardized Emergency Management System; and

18 WHEREAS, the Lake County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services, in conjunction
19 with the offices, departments, municipal agencies and other key partners in the Operational Area,
20 has developed an updated EOP for the County of Lake and the Lake County Operational Area,
21 and said plan has been made available to the public and all concerned agencies for review and
22 comment; and

23 WHEREAS, the Lake County Disaster Council was convened on December 13, 2017,
24 and approved by motion a recommendation to forward the proposed EOP to the Board of

Supervisors for adoption for the County of Lake and the Lake County Operational Area;
and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors gives its full support to this revised EOP and urges
all officials, employees, public and private organizations, and residents, individually and
collectively, to do their share in furthering the total emergency response effort of the County of
Lake; and

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Lake County Sheriff/Coroner, in his capacity as
Director of Emergency Services, shall exercise due diligence to maintain the EOP as a vital,
current and dynamic plan to address all hazards; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Lake County Board of Supervisors,
that the attached EOP dated May ___, 2018, is hereby approved and adopted and supersedes all
previous versions.

This resolution was passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of
Lake, State of California, at a regular meeting thereof on this ___ day of _____ 2018, and
