Dear Supervisor Steele,

As you know, the Natural Resources Agency is tasked by AB 707 (Aguiar-Curry, Chapter 842, Statutes of 2017) with the creation of a Blue Ribbon Committee for the Rehabilitation of Clear Lake (the Committee). The Committee is tasked with identifying, and reporting on, potential solutions to water quality issues for Clear Lake. The Committee will also make recommendations for potential funding sources for restoration activities. As such, we are requesting that you provide information on the County of Lake Board of Supervisors appointees to the Committee. Specifically:

- 1. One member of the Board of Supervisors.
- 2. An expert in local economic development.
- 3. An expert in agriculture.
- 4. An expert in the environment.
- 5. A representative of a public water supplier that draws its drinking water supply from Clear Lake.

For each of (2)-(4) above, please provide a biography that explains how the appointee will meet the intent of AB 707 to represent that subject area.

The Committee shall meet quarterly in Lake County for the purposes of discussion, reviewing research, planning, and providing oversight regarding the health of Clear Lake. The first meeting of the Committee will take place in May, 2018. The Committee will be subject to the requirements of the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act.
