NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TRANSFER COUNTY PROPERTY NOT REQUIRED FOR PUBLIC USE, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 25365 RECITALS

WHEREAS, Government Code section 25365 authorizes a County Board of Supervisors, by a four-fifths vote, to grant convey, quitclaim, assign, or otherwise transfer to the state or to any community redevelopment agency, housing authority, community development commission, surplus property authority, federal agency, city, school district, county board of education, special district, joint powers agency, or any other public agency within the county or exchange with those public agencies, any real or personal property, or interest therein belonging to the county upon the terms and conditions as are agreed upon and without complying with any other provisions of this code, if the property or interest therein to be granted and conveyed or quitclaimed is not required for county use or in the event of an exchange, the property to be acquired is required for county use; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Sheriff's Office is in possession of a 2010 Ford Crown Victoria pursuit vehicle, VIN No. FABP7V6AX115443, a 2009 Ford Crown Victoria pursuit vehicle, VIN No. 2FAHP71V29X129833, and a 2009 Ford Crown Victoria pursuit vehicle, VIN No. 2FAHP71V69X129835, which are surplus to its needs and not otherwise required for County use; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clearlake has a present use for all of the above-described personal property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Lake, State California, that it finds, determines and hereby declares that:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and hereby adopted by this Board.
- 2. That personal property herein described as a 2010 Ford Crown Victoria pursuit vehicle, VIN No. FABP7V6AX115443, a 2009 Ford Crown Victoria pursuit vehicle, VIN No. 2FAHP71V29X129833, and a 2009 Ford Crown Victoria pursuit vehicle, VIN No. 2FAHP71V69X129835, are hereby declared surplus to the needs of the County.
- 3. It is the intention of the County to transfer said property to the City of Clearlake.
