3 NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TRANSFER COUNTY PROPERTY NOT REQUIRED

4 FOR PUBLIC USE, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 25365

5 RECITALS

6 WHEREAS, Government Code section 25365 authorizes a County Board of Supervisors, by a
7 four-fifths vote, to grant convey, quitclaim, assign, or otherwise transfer to the state or to any
8 community redevelopment agency, housing authority, community development commission, surplus
9 property authority, federal agency, city, school district, county board of education, special district, joint
10 powers agency, or any other public agency within the county or exchange with those public agencies,
11 any real or personal property, or interest therein belonging to the county upon the terms and conditions
12 as are agreed upon and without complying with any other provisions of this code, if the property or
13 interest therein to be granted and conveyed or quitclaimed is not required for county use or in the event
14 of an exchange, the property to be acquired is required for county use; and

15 WHEREAS, the Lake County Sheriff's Office is in possession of a 24-foot 2001 Godfrey
16 Sweetwater Pontoon Boat, HIN#GDY2112EJ001, and trailer, HIN#4H1062829X0254844, which is
17 surplus to its needs and is not otherwise required for County use; and

18 WHEREAS, the Northshore Fire Protection District, an independent special district in the
19 County of Lake, has a present use for said pontoon board and trailer.

20 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, County of Lake,
21 State California, that it finds, determines and hereby declares that:

- 22 1. The above recitals are true and correct and hereby adopted by this Board.
23 2. That personal property herein described as a 24-foot 2001 Godfrey Sweetwater pontoon
24 boat, HIN#GDY2112EJ001 and a Pontoon Boat trailer, HIN#4H1062829X0254844 is
25 hereby declared surplus to the needs of the County.
26 3. It is the intention of the County to transfer said property to the Northshore Fire Protection
27 District.

4. The Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board to publish a notice of this intended action pursuant to Government Code section 6061.

5. The Board will consider action as to the conveyance of the above-described personal property to the Northshore Fire Protection District at the regularly-scheduled public meeting of this Board on June 5, 2018 at _____.
