RE: An Ordinance Amending Chapter 21, Article 27 of the Lake County Code Pertaining to Cannabis Manufacturing, Distribution, and Testing

Dear Board of Supervisors,

Thank you for having another Cannabis Workshop today and providing the opportunity for entrepreneurs to create a life and jobs in Lake County. Unfortunately, I cannot make it but had a couple questions.

1. Is there be any possibility of splitting out the cannabis business activities for individual ordinances?
 - a. I saw the opposition to manufacturing of any kind at the last Cannabis Workshop. Many growers will need the ability to self-distribute and there will be a need for testing laboratories. If the less controversial businesses were in their own ordinance, it would allow those businesses to each business get going and possibly alleviate a backlog of approvals for the planning department.
2. Type N Manufacturing
 - a. This manufacturing permit is taking oil that is processed elsewhere and putting it into topicals or edibles. Would it be possible for this to be its own ordinance as the volatile or non-volatile extraction could happen somewhere other than Lake County?
3. One-mile distance from highways
 - a. Is there a precedence or reason behind this?
 - i. This may make it difficult for small businesses
4. Is there a section for Dispensaries in this ordinance?
 - a. If there is not, will there be a Dispensary ordinance or is it in another section of the Lake County Codes?
5. Section 4 typos
 - a. I think there are some typos in Section 4 (pp. 47-50). It says, "Cannabis Testing" and Section 4 pertains to Distribution.
