ORDER APPROVING FINAL PARCEL MAP AND THE SIGNING OF THE FINAL PARCEL
MAP
(STREKFUS PM 15-06)

RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake, State of California, that it Finds, Determines, Orders and hereby Declares THAT:

1. 9435 Konocti Bay Road II, LLC, a California Limited Liability Company, has had surveyed and platted, and has consented to the preparation and recordation of that certain Parcel Map entitled, "Parcel Map PM 15-06, being a portion of Section 22, Township 13 North, Range 8 West, M.D.B. & M., Lake County Records, County of Lake, California";

2. It appears that each and all of the provisions and requirements of the Subdivision Map Act (Gov. Code Secs. 66410, et seq.) and each and all of the provisions and requirements of Chapter 17 of the Lake County Ordinance Code have been complied with.

3. This Final Parcel Map is consistent with the Lake County General Plan.

4. This Final Parcel Map is statutorily exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Title 14 California Code of Regulations, Section 15268, subdivision (b)(3) Ministerial Projects.

5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Final Parcel Map is hereby approved and accepted and the Clerk of the Board is authorized to sign said map, and the Irrevocable Offer of Dedication of the public roadway and public utility easement shown as Konocti Bay Road is hereby accepted for public use. The roadway easement designated as Konocti Bay Road is accepted into the County-maintained Road System.
