COMPREHENSIVE DESCRIPTION, JUSTIFICATION, AND COST SUMMARY: On 4/14/18 Granite initiated RFI 029 after compromising an unmarked, or identified 6 inch water line during potholing, while performing extra work excavation of the existing concrete encased storm drain pipe for installation of new RCP at approx. Sta. 17+00 off Foothill. The existing water main was within the concrete encasement in direct contact with the existing culvert. The existing water main was approximately 0.7 feet above the designed flowline of the new RCP. Immediately following the break, and shut down, attempts were made to have the Clear Lake Oaks Community Water District (CLOCWD) handle the required off set of the water main. After multiple attempts, and a face to face discussion on 4/20/18 is was determined the District would not handle the required work for the planned improvements to occur. Granite was directed to proceed T&M to complete the required lowering of the water main, using County Detail -- Water Main Lowering dated, May 2009, File No. Std. - 855 as reference for the work. Based on discussions with the District Granite was authorized to use PVC C900 material for the work. Work started on Tuesday, 4/24/18, with the District handling shutdown and noticing of the shutdown, of the water service. As well as cutting the existing water line pipe at the requested locations by Granite. Comprising the water line shut down extra work operations, and installation of the identified fix, generated two additional days being awarded to the contractor.
