**RESOLUTION DECLARING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS INTENTION TO SELL
PROPERTY NOT REQUIRED FOR PUBLIC USE,
LOCATED AT 934-946 BEVINS COURT, LAKEPORT, CALIFORNIA (APN'S 025-462-100 &
090), PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 25520 ET SEQ.**

WHEREAS, in December 2001, the County of Lake acquired the property located at 934-946 Bevins Court in Lakeport, as described in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, the two lots have remained undeveloped and no plans or funding are available to consider developing the properties; and

WHEREAS, private parties have expressed interest in purchasing the property; and

WHEREAS, the minimum bid price has been established by including both a recent appraisal and the estimated broker costs; and

WHEREAS, the property is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15312 (a), (b) (3).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LAKE as follows:

1. The subject property is hereby declared as surplus to the needs of Lake County and the Board declares its intention to sell the property, subject to the terms and conditions contained in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, at a minimum bid price of \$294,000.
2. Sealed proposals and oral bids to purchase the property will be received and considered during the regularly scheduled meeting on August 7, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. in the Board of Supervisors Chambers, County Courthouse, 255 North Forbes Street, Lakeport, California.
3. The Clerk of the Board is directed to cause the notice of the adoption of this Resolution and of the time and place of holding the public meeting to be given as follows:
 - A. Posting copies of this resolution in three (3) public places in the County, not less than fifteen (15) days from the date of the public meeting as follows:
 1. At the Lake County Courthouse, Lakeport, California.
 2. At the Lake County Library, Lakeport, California.
 3. At the Lake County Redbud Library, Clearlake, California

B. Publishing the notice pursuant to Government Code Section 6063 in the Record Bee, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County.

4. The County reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive irregularities in any bid received.
5. The Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to execute a grant deed to be delivered by the County Administrative Officer to the escrow company.
6. The County Administrative Officer is hereby authorized and empowered to execute all other necessary documents to list and sell the subject property.
