

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A BENEFIT ASSESMENT FOR ALL PARCELS WITHIN COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 16 -- PARADISE VALLEY

WHEREAS, County Service Area #16 requires funding to complete a consolidation project with Clearlake Oaks County Water District that will alleviate capacity and health and safety issues with public drinking water; and

WHEREAS, the consolidation project will benefit every property owner within the boundaries of County Service Area #16 by alleviating the lack of source capacity and lifting the long standing connection moratorium; and

WHEREAS, County Service Area #16 must secure a loan to complete the project which is to be repaid by the property owners within the service area boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, the governing board of County Service Area #16, Paradise Valley Water System wishes to impose a special \$ 3,110 per parcel benefit assessment within the boundaries of County Service Area #16 to be used for the purpose of completing the consolidation project; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 218, Article XIID of the California Constitution provides a process to implement property related benefit assessments, and said process has been followed; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to charge the assessment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake ordains as follows:

Section 1

- 1. An assessment of \$3,110 per parcel will be implemented on all parcels within County Service Area #16.
- 2. The assessment will be placed on the property tax roll in the manner authorized by the Revenue and Taxation Code.
- 3. The fee will be paid over a period of two years, resulting in two equal annual payments of \$1,555 per year.

Section 2:

- 1. This ordinance will survive the county service area after the consolidation is complete and funds collected with this assessment will repay the loan obtained to complete the consolidation.
- 2. All ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict and no further.
