A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A GEOTHERMAL IMPACT MITIGATION FUND AND COMBINING THE ANDERSON SPRINGS AND COBB VALLEY COMMITTEES INTO THE GEOTHERMAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, this Board has created a Geothermal Impact Fund, comprised of two committees, the Anderson Springs Committee and the Cobb Valley Committee, whose purpose is to facilitate and foster direct communication between the community and geothermal operators at the Geysers and identify adverse impacts to those communities and consider funding requests to mitigate said impacts; and

WHEREAS, the recent events, including natural disasters have resulted in a dramatic reduction in the number of residents in Anderson Springs and Cobb Valley, creating a more common denominator of concerns of and between the two communities; and

WHEREAS, the Anderson Springs and Cobb Valley committees can effectively communicate concerns and consider funding requests as a combined Geothermal Advisory Committee in a joint forum; and

WHEREAS, it is an efficient use of both committee members' time and resources for the newly combined and created Geothermal Advisory Committee to meet on a quarterly basis.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND DETERMINED that:

1. This Board does hereby amend the resolution establishing a Geothermal Impact
Mitigation Fund as contained in Exhibit "A" attached thereto to combine the Anderson Springs
Committee and the Cobb Valley Committee into the Geothermal Advisory Committee.
