RESOLUTION OF INTENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LAKE DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO CONSIDER AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 21 OF THE LAKE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR COMMERCIAL CANNABIS CULTIVATION APPLICANTS TO BE ENROLLED WITH THE REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD OR STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AS OF APRIL 19, 2018 AND TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR A CONDITIONAL CERTIFICATE OF RECOGNITION (SELF CERTIFICATION) OF COMPLIANCE WITH ARTICLE 72 IN ORDER TO APPLY FOR EARLY ACTIVATION OF USE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake, State of California, desires to amend the Lake County Ordinance Code, Chapter 21, Zoning Ordinance, to remove the requirement for commercial cannabis cultivation applicants to be enrolled with the Regional Water Quality Control Board or State Water Resources Control Board as of April 19, 2018 and to remove the requirement for a Conditional Certificate of Recognition (Self Certification) of Compliance with Article 72 in order to apply for Early Activation of Use to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAKE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS HEREBY FINDS, ORDERS, DETERMINES AND DECLARES THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> It is the intention of the Board of Supervisors to initiate the proposed zoning ordinance text amendment to recommend the modification of the existing as set forth below for the following reasons:

EXHIBIT B

- 1. The proposed amendments are consistent the provisions of the Lake County General Plan and Zoning Ordinance.
- 2. This proposed amendments are necessary to protect the health and safety and welfare of the County.
- 3. The proposed amendments would increase economic development opportunities.
- 4. The project will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts, and the project is exempt from CEQA.
- Section 2. Subsection (at) 4(d)a. of Section 27.13 of Chapter 21 of the Lake County Code is hereby amended to read:

A person interested in applying for a cannabis cultivation use permit shall be enrolled with the applicable Regional Water Quality Control Board or State Water Resources Control Board for water quality protection program or written verification from the appropriate board that enrollment is not necessary.

Subsection 3: Subsection (at) 4(e)c. of Section 27.13 of Chapter 21 of the Lake County Code is hereby deleted:

The applicant shall a Conditional Certificate of Recognition of Compliance for compliance with Article 72.

Section 4. The Community Development Department is directed to prepare the report to effectuate this zoning ordinance text amendment.
