3                   **RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION'S DISASTER-**  
4                   **ONLY 2-1-1 SERVICE DIALING IMPLEMENTATION, WITH 2-1-1 VENTURA COUNTY**

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6                   **WHEREAS**, on July 21, 2000 ([FCC 00-256](#)), the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) assigned  
7 the three-digit dialing code 2-1-1, "To be used for access to community information and referral  
8 services," nationwide; and

10                   **WHEREAS**, 2-1-1 implementation in California is undertaken on a county-by-county basis, per  
11 California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) [Decision 03-02-029](#), issued February 13, 2003; and

13                   **WHEREAS**, CPUC [Decision 11-09-016](#) authorized disaster-only 2-1-1 services in California, and  
14 2016's [SB 1212 \(Hueso\)](#) authorized the CPUC to expend \$1.5 million toward disaster-only 2-1-1  
15 programs in unserved California Counties; and

17                   **WHEREAS**, Lake County staff have participated with representatives of 18 other counties in a [statewide](#)  
18 [initiative](#) intended to implement disaster-only 2-1-1 in all presently unserved California counties; and

20                   **WHEREAS**, through a competitive bidding process, [2-1-1 Ventura County](#) has been selected as the  
21 provider to facilitate this implementation; and

23                   **WHEREAS**, Disaster-Only 2-1-1 implementation is expected to streamline the delivery of information  
24 regarding services available to the general public during the course of, and in recovery from, disaster  
25 events, and Ventura 2-1-1's proposal would allow Lake County to stand up this service when  
26 designated County personnel deem it will provide a public benefit; and

28                   **WHEREAS**, 2-1-1 would be a toll-free number that could provide fast access to disaster-related  
29 information while minimizing the direct impact upon Emergency Operations Center and/or Joint  
30 Information Center resources; and

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**WHEREAS**, SB 1212 funds will cover infrastructure and initial 2-1-1 Ventura County implementation costs for all counties electing to participate in the statewide Disaster-Only 2-1-1 implementation; and

**WHEREAS**, each of the [Counties surrounding Lake](#) has either implemented or is in the process of implementing at least Disaster-Only 2-1-1 service, and availability of 2-1-1 in surrounding areas is key to the effectiveness of this information resource when residents are evacuated to neighboring counties.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:**

The Lake County Board of Supervisors supports the California Public Utilities Commission's Disaster-Only 2-1-1 service dialing implementation, in partnership with 2-1-1 Ventura County.
