3	A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2018-118, ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY
4	ALTERNATE OFFICE HOURS FOR COUNTY OFFICES LOCATED WITHIN AND SURROUNDING
5	THE LAKE COUNTY COURTHOUSE BUILDING
6	WHEREAS, section 24260 of the California Government Code provides in all Counties, County
7	officers shall keep their offices open for the transaction of business during such hours and on such days
8	as are fixed by the Board of Supervisors, by Ordinance or Resolution; and
9	WHEREAS, Lake County Code section 2-2.1, establishes that all County offices must be open
10	for the transaction of business continuously from 8:00a.m. until 5:00p.m., every day except Saturdays,
11	Sundays, and holidays, unless otherwise provided by Ordinance; and
12	WHEREAS, in 2009, closures from 12:00 noon to 1:00p.m. were permitted under section 2-2.2,
13	in recognition of the need for appropriate flexibility in the face of the economic downturn; and
14	WHEREAS, severe economic conditions have persisted, and Lake County's recovery from the
15	recession has been slower than many California jurisdictions, per the California State Association of
16	Counties, resulting in reduced and less experienced staffing across many County departments; and
17	WHEREAS, unprecedented natural disasters of 2015-2019 further reduced County revenues,
18	and flexibility was needed to solve departmental issues and redesign business practices; and
19	WHEREAS, in 2017, Lake County Code Section 2-2.2 was amended, broadening the
20	circumstances wherein noontime closures were allowed under Department Head authority, and
21	providing that further reduced office hours may be permitted by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors,
22	in recognition that customary practices may unsustainable; and
23	WHEREAS, the County has, thus far, been unsuccessful in pursuit of additional revenue
24	streams to sustain County operations, and our dire financial condition continues to worsen; and
25	WHEREAS, County departments continue to operate with high vacancy rates and reduced
26	staffing patterns, and are not able to provide all normal services; and
27	WHEREAS, on August 28, 2018, by Resolution No. 2018-118, the Board of Supervisors
28	authorized, for the period of September 11, 2018 – March 10, 2019, all County offices located in the
29	Lake County Courthouse building at 255 N. Forbes St., Lakeport, and select surrounding and satellite

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1	offices of the County of Lake, to be open to the public for the transaction of business continuously from		
2	8:00a.m. until 5:00p.m., every day except Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays; and		
3	WHEREAS, on December 4, 2018, this Board unanimously adopted a Fiscal Crisis		
4	Management Plan, affirming support of policy changes that create business efficiencies and allow		
5	departments to respond to challenges, such as fluctuations and reductions in staffing; and		
6	WHEREAS, on March 12, 2019, by Resolution No. 2019-35, this Board extended reduced		
7	public office hours for an additional six month period, through September 10, 2019; and		
8	WHEREAS, it remains the desire of this Board to provide the best possible customer service,		
9	and uninterrupted staff time has significantly improved many departments' capacity to efficiently manage		
10	heavy workloads.		
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:		
12	For an additional six month period, from September 10, 2019 - March 10, 2020, all County		
13	offices located within the Lake County Courthouse building at 255 N. Forbes St., Lakeport, and select		
14	surrounding and satellite offices of the County of Lake, shall be open to the public for the transaction of		
15	business continuously from 8:00a.m. until 5:00p.m., every day except Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and		
16	holidays.
