Request for Meal Price Adjustment

Dear Lieutenant Findley:

It has been an honor and a pleasure to provide inmate food services at the Lake County Jail. As you will recall, effective August 1, 2019 our Agreement expires, but thereafter allows for annual extensions which may be exercised upon mutual consent of the parties. Moreover, the Agreement calls for meal prices to be adjusted annually, effective on the anniversary/renewal date, based on the change in the Consumer Price Index, Food Away From Home. I have attached a copy of the data released by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and as you will see, the relevant index increased by 3.1%. Based on this adjustment, I have prepared and attached a revised meal price scale to go into effect August 1, 2019.
