2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-118**

3 **RESOLUTION GRANTING AUTHORITY TO WAIVE TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX**
4 **INTEREST & PENALTIES ON APPEAL BY AN OPERATOR**

5 WHEREAS, Section 7280 of the Revenue and Taxation Code permits a county to levy
6 a tax on the privilege of occupancy for lodging establishments within the unincorporated
7 areas of the county; and

8 WHEREAS, the Uniform Transient Occupancy Tax Article of the County of Lake Code
9 was adopted in 1965 implementing said tax; and

10 WHEREAS, mandatory penalties and interest are assessed on any delinquent taxes
11 imposed by this article pursuant to Section 18-17; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tax Collector does not have the authority to waive penalties and
13 interest when making a final determination of taxes due, pursuant to Section 18-18; and

14 WHEREAS, new enforcement efforts have resulted in lodging operators, following
15 said final determination by the Tax Collector, filing appeals to the Board of Supervisors
16 pursuant to Section 18-19.

17 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that:

- 18 1. Upon receipt of an appeal to the Board of Supervisors, the County Administrative
19 Officer may undertake a review of the materials prior to the hearing date. Authority
20 would be granted to consider waivers of interest and penalties for first-time
21 operators within the last 3 years.
- 22 2. Any waiver of penalties and interest provided would be contingent upon receipt of
23 payment in full, or strict compliance with the terms of a payment plan.
- 24 3. If a successful resolution cannot be reached, the appeal would proceed to a
25 hearing before the Board of Supervisors per Section 18-19.
