3	A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ALL LAKE COUNTY LIBRARY
4	BRANCHES IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 AND PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS c20-1 and c20-2
5	WHEREAS, section 24260 of the California Government Code provides in all Counties, County
6	officers shall keep their offices open for the transaction of business during such hours and on such days
7	as are fixed by the Board of Supervisors, by Ordinance or Resolution; and
8	WHEREAS, Lake County Code section 2-2.1, establishes that all County offices must be open
9	for the transaction of business continuously from 8:00a.m. until 5:00p.m., every day except Saturdays,
10	Sundays, and holidays, unless otherwise provided by Ordinance; and
11	WHEREAS, Lake County Code Section 2-2.3 specifies normative hours of operation for the
12	Lakeport, Redbud, Middletown and Upper Lake branches of the Lake County Library system; and
13	WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3069 was passed by the Lake County Board of Supervisors
14	November 7, 2017, enabling authorization of temporary alternate hours in the event of persistent
15	extraordinary circumstances by Resolution of this Board; and
16	WHEREAS, March 9, 2020, Lake County's Public Health Officer declared a Local Health
17	Emergency in Lake County, pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 101080, in response to a novel
18	coronavirus, COVID-19; and
19	WHEREAS, the presence of an emergency related to COVID-19 was affirmed March 10, 2020
20	by this Board, and later echoed by Lake County Sheriff Brian Martin, March 13, 2020; and
21	WHEREAS, as of 6pm March 14, 2020, COVID-19, had caused six deaths in the State of
22	California, and 335 positive cases had been confirmed, and limiting the virus' spread is a matter of
23	urgent and significant statewide and national priority; and
24	WHEREAS, in response to guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the
25	Administration of the President of the United States, the California Department of Public Health (CDPH)
26	and the Office of the Governor of the State of California and local public health officials, library systems
27	across California, including neighboring Sonoma County and the California State Library, have
28	temporarily closed, in an effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19; and
29	WHEREAS, Monday, March 16, 2020, Lake County's Public Health Officer, Gary Pace, MD,
30	MPH, issued Orders No. c20-1 and c20-2, which collectively discouraged non-essential public

1	gatherings, and this Board is informed Dr. Pace likewise advised the County Librarian it would be		
2	prudent to close all County Libraries to the public, at this time.		
3	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:		
4	For the period of March 17, 2020 – April 5, 2020, all County Library branches will be closed to		
5	the public, noting access the library system will still be available at <u>http://library.lakecountyca.gov</u> , and		
6	library staff will be available during normal operating hours to assist patrons by phone or email in		
7	accessing online resources.		
8	THIS RESOLUTION was passed and adopted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Lake		
9	at a regular meeting thereof on the 17 <sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020 by the following vote:
