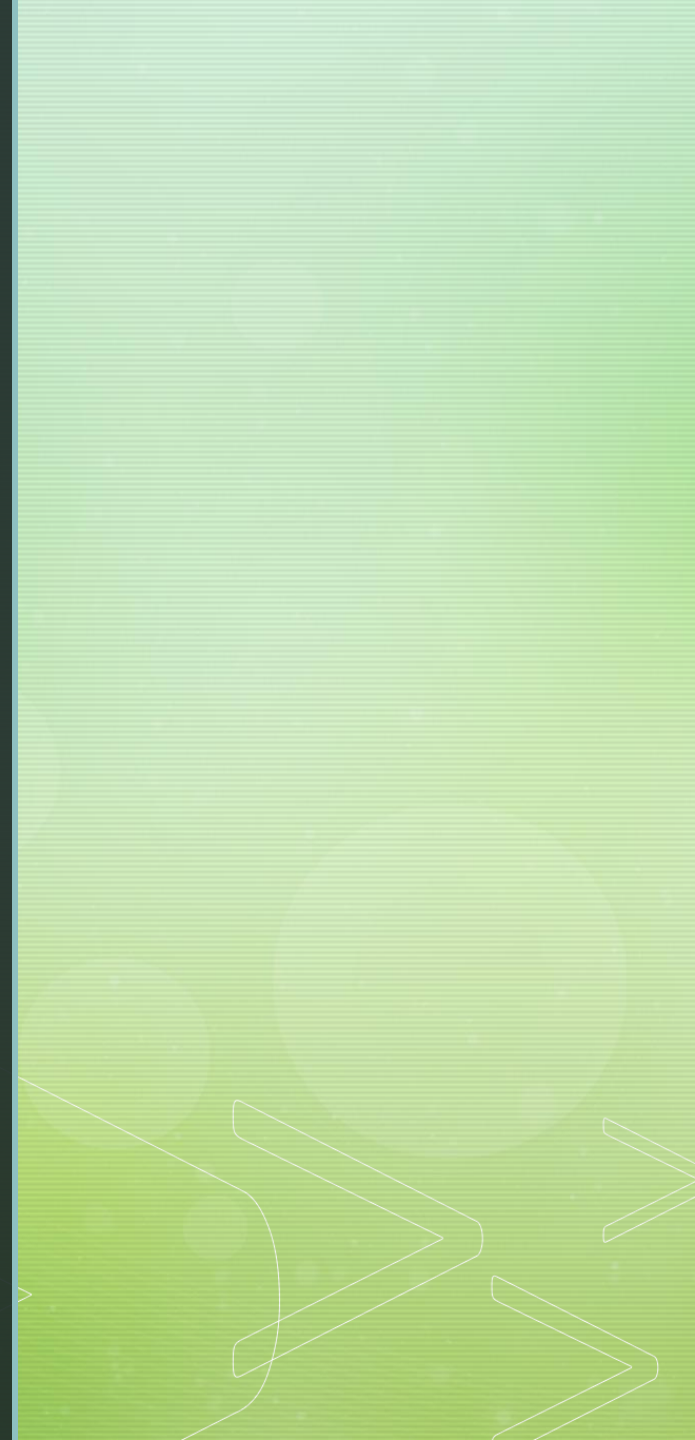


# Cannabis Ordinance Revisions

Part of Article 27 of Chapter  
21 of the Lake County  
Zoning Ordinance



# ■ Acre and Plant Count Changes

- Type 1 – Maximum 5,000 sq ft changed to unlimited plants
- Type 1A - indoor – Maximum 5,000 sq ft changed from 5 acre minimum to 2 acre minimum
- Type 1C - outdoor – Maximum 2,500 sq ft changed to unlimited plants
- Type 2A - indoor – Changed from 20 acre minimum to 2 acre minimum
- Type 3A - indoor – Changed from 20 acre minimum to 2 acre minimum
- Acre change opens up close to 900 new parcels for use.

## Processing Zone

- Add processing license to PDC

## Water Board Permit

- Add expiration date for obtaining water board permit to help manage the growth of the cannabis industry in the county.
- October 31, 2020 is proposed

## Background Checks

- Allow temporary work status while background checks are being processed.
- No permit if applicant fails background checks

## Video Surveillance

- Instead of 24/7 365 days a year, it has been changed to 24/7 during active cannabis operations.

# Microbusiness

- Add retail license to Microbusiness in order to allow for cannabis resort operations in the county
- Allow all Microbusiness licenses in areas zoned for Microbusiness
