PC 832 Firearms Familiarization is a 24-hour course designed to comply with California Penal Code 832 as well as requirements by Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST). This course is a basic introduction to the legal aspects of shooting and safety. Topics include: handgun familiarization, safety, shooting principles and live fire exercises. Because this course is designed to provide practical hands on training in police tactics and weapon usage, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participant.

Attendance is mandatory. Students are strongly encouraged to arrive on time in order to complete the registration process and avoid impeding instructional time. Late students who mis this process will not be allowed to attend the course.

IMPORTANT NOTE: A Glock Model 19 9mm semi-automatic pistol is provided for this course. Personal and non-Law Enforcement Agency assigned weapons are not allowed.
