BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA 1 2 RESOLUTION NO. 3 A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING TEMPORARY ALTERNATE OFFICE HOURS FOR COUNTY 4 OFFICES LOCATED WITHIN AND SURROUNDING THE LAKE COUNTY COURTHOUSE BUILDING 5 WHEREAS, section 24260 of the California Government Code provides in all Counties, County 6 officers shall keep their offices open for the transaction of business during such hours and on such days 7 as are fixed by the Board of Supervisors, by Ordinance or Resolution; and 8 WHEREAS, Lake County Code section 2-2.1, establishes that all County offices must be open 9 for the transaction of business continuously from 8:00a.m. until 5:00p.m., every day except Saturdays, 10 Sundays, and holidays, unless otherwise provided by Ordinance; and 11 WHEREAS, in 2009, closures from 12:00 noon to 1:00p.m. were permitted under section 2-2.2, 12 in recognition of the need for appropriate flexibility in the face of the economic downturn; and 13 WHEREAS, severe general economic conditions have persisted, and Lake County's recovery 14 from the recession has been slower than many California jurisdictions, per the California State 15 Association of Counties, resulting in reduced and less experienced staffing across many County 16 departments; and 17 WHEREAS, unprecedented natural disasters of 2015-2017 further reduced County revenues, 18 and greater flexibility was needed to solve complex departmental issues and redesign business 19 practices through various means; and 20 WHEREAS, in 2017, Lake County Code Section 2-2.2 was amended, broadening the 21 circumstances wherein noontime closures were allowed under Department Head authority, and 22 providing that further reduced office hours may be permitted by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors, 23 in recognition that customary practices may unsustainable; and 24 WHEREAS, the County has, thus far, been unsuccessful in pursuit of additional revenue 25 streams to sustain County operations, and our dire financial condition is worsening; and 26 WHEREAS, the Pawnee, Ranch and River fires of 2018 have collectively destroyed more than 27 150 residences and mobile homes, and consumed hundreds of thousands of acres, and the full impact 28 of these fires is not yet known, but immediate and significant efforts must be undertaken to mitigate both 29 the workload and financial effects of these catastrophic disasters; and

WHEREAS, County departments have recently operated with an average vacancy rate of 20%, and are not able to provide all normal services in the face of chronic understaffing, repeated disasters and severe financial challenge, which have collectively strained departments in numerous ways, including high employee turnover; and WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Board to continue to provide the best possible customer service, and uninterrupted staff time remains an ongoing need to manage workloads, at this time.
