RESOLUTION ADOPTING SANTA CLARA TENTATIVE SUBDIVISION MAP (SD 20-01) FOR THE GUENOC VALLEY MIXED USE COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has conducted a duly noticed public hearing on an Santa Clara Tentative Subdivision Map (SD 20-01; Exhibit A) in Middletown for the Guenoc Valley Mixed Use Commercial Development Project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the environmental effects of the proposed Santa Clara Tentative Subdivision Map (SD 20-01) in Middletown, subject to the Conditions of Approval, and as set forth in the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors determined that the Final EIR is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Santa Clara Tentative Subdivision Map (SD 20-01), in Middletown, as conditioned, is consistent with the goals and objectives of the Lake County Zoning Ordinance, the General Plan, and the Middletown Area Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara Tentative Subdivision Map (SD 20-01), in Middletown, as conditioned, is consistent with the State Subdivision Map Act and Chapter 17 of the Lake County Code; and

WHEREAS, Structural fire protection and suppression services will be available for the subdivision through the South Lake Fire Protection District and the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection Services (Calfire); and

WHEREAS, ingress and egress for the subdivision meets the regulations regarding road standards for the fire equipment access adopted pursuant to Section 4290 and 4291 of the Public Resource Code and any applicable ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Santa Clara Tentative Subdivision Map (SD 20-01), in Middletown will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, and general welfare.
