RESOLUTION ADOPTING GUENOC VALLEY TENTATIVE SUBDIVISIONS MAPS (SD 18-01) FOR THE GUENOC VALLEY MIX USE COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has conducted a duly noticed public hearing on an Guenoc Valley Tentative Subdivision Maps (SD 18-01) to include the Bohan Rdige, Denniston Golf Estates, Equestrian, Maha Farms, and Trout Flat Subdivisions (included as Exhibit A) for the Guenoc Valley Mixed Use Commercial Development Project, subject to the Conditions of Approval, and with recommendations and the reasons therefore: and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the environmental effects of the proposed Guenoc Valley Tentative Subdivision Maps (SD 18-01) as set forth in the Final Environmental Impact Report and on July 7, 2020, at a duly noticed public hearing, has certified the Final EIR that was prepared for Guenoc Valley Mixed Use Commercial Development Project is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has certified the Final EIR and independently reviewed and evaluated the CEQA Findings of Fact and Statement of Overriding Considerations referenced and/or enumerated herein; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Guenoc Valley Tentative Subdivision Maps (SD 18-01), subject to the Conditions of Approval, is consistent with the goals and objectives of the Lake County Zoning Ordinance, the General Plan and the Middletown Area Plan, and,

WHEREAS, Guenoc Valley Tentative Subdivision Maps (SD 18-01) consistent with the State Subdivision Map Act and Chapter 17 of the Lake County Code; and

WHEREAS, Structural fire protection and suppression services will be available for the subdivision through the South Lake Fire Protection District and the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection Services (Calfire);

WHEREAS, ingress and egress for the subdivision meets the regulations regarding road standards for the fire equipment access adopted pursuant to Section 4290 and 4291 of the Public Resource Code and any applicable ordinances, and

WHEREAS, the Guenoc Valley Tentative Subdivision Maps (SD 18-01) will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, and general welfare. A detailed analysis of hazards is included in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the project, especially Section 3.8 – Hazards and Section 3.16 – Wildfire. Elements of the project will serve to ensure public health, safety, and general welfare, and one of the primary objectives of the agreement is to confirm the timely construction of the proposed emergency response center; and
