RESOLUTION ADOPTING DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT (DA 18-01) FOR THE GUENOC VALLEY MIXED USE COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has conducted a duly noticed public hearing on a Development Agreement Resolution (DA 18-01; Exhibit A) for the Guenoc valley Mixed Use Commercial Development Project, subject to the Conditions of Approval for the General Plan and Specific Plan of Development, with recommendations and the reasons therefore; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has reviewed and considered the environmental effects of the proposed Development Agreement Resolution (DA 18-01), as conditioned and as set forth in the Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors found the Final EIR is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA Guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has independently reviewed and evaluated the CEQA Findings of Fact and Statement of Overriding Considerations referenced herein; and

WHEREAS, on July 7, 2020, at a duly noticed public hearing, the Board of Supervisors certified the Final EIR that was prepared for Guenoc Valley Mixed Use Commercial Development Project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement ensures consistency with the goals and objectives of the General Plan and the Middletown Area Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement (DA 18-01) is consistent with Article 69 (Development Agreements) with the Lake County Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, is consistent with the objective, policies, general land uses, and programs specified in the General Plan as well as the Middletown Area Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement (DA 18-01) is compatible with the uses authorized in, the regulation prescribed for, and the zoning district in which the real property is located; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement (DA 18-01) is in conformity with the public convenience, general welfare, and good land use practice; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement (DA 18-01) will not adversely affect the orderly development of property or the preservation of property values; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement (DA 18-01) outlines a project as described in the General Plan of Development and the Specific Plan of Development for the new zoning district GVD (Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Development Agreement (DA 18-01) provides for public convenience and economic viability for the surrounding community as required by the Lake County Economic Development Plan 2016; and
