RESOLUTION NO. 2018-77

A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 6-5 of the Lake County Code empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when Lake County is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the County Board of Supervisors is not in session, subject to ratification by the Board of Supervisors within seven days: and

WHEREAS, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within the County of Lake, caused by the Pawnee Fire in Spring Valley, resulting in lost structures and other serious damage to the County; which began on the 23 day of June, 2018, at which time the Board of Supervisors was not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff, as Director of Emergency Services of the County of Lake did proclaim the existence of a local emergency within the County on the 24 day of June, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors does hereby find that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril did warrant and necessitate the proclamation of the existence of a local emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED and ordered that said local emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until it's termination is proclaimed by the Lake County Board of Supervisors. The necessity for the continuation of this proclamation shall be reviewed by Board of Supervisors every 30 days until deemed no longer necessary.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of Lake County shall be those prescribed by state law, by ordinances, and resolutions of the County.

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the proclamation ratified by this act be submitted to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services, requesting activation of the California Disaster Assistance Act for Lake County; and further requesting that this emergency proclamation be forwarded to the Federal Emergency Management Administration for consideration under the Stafford Act.
