I am a public health leader, manager, and epidemiologist with over 12 years of experience in local and state health departments, hospital, and research settings in California. Currently, I am the executive director of a new organization called the ACE (Adverse Childhood Experiences) Resource Network with Anonymous Philanthropy. I am also consulting for other philanthropic foundations and non-profits, a school district, and First 5 Sonoma County. My previous clients include a county health department, a rural hospital, and a telemedicine company.

Prior to my consulting work, I spent my career in public health and disaster preparedness and response. From 2013-2019 I worked as an epidemiologist and then Epidemiology & Assessment Manager for the Sonoma County, CA health department. I led epidemiological and evaluation services to inform community planning, and supported healthcare planning and outreach. Prior to this, I provided epidemiological and communication services to the California Office of Binational Border Health, conducting surveillance for emerging pathogens and improving public health stakeholder communication in the California/Baja California border region. I also worked at UC San Diego - Division of Global Health and the Berkeley Survey Research Center on public health studies, and had my first experience in hospital and public health preparedness and response in the UC Davis Medical Center Emergency Preparedness Department during the emergence of 2009 H1N1.

I have a unique combination of public health management, leadership, and epidemiological experience at local and state levels, consulting experience in the health and healthcare philanthropic sector, and disaster response training and experience (notably as the Logistics Chief during the 2017 Sonoma Complex Fires). I have managed public health and disaster responses teams throughout my career. Additionally, in 2019, I completed a national fellowship on health equity with Human Impact Partners.
