

Records at this office were reviewed to determine if this project could adversely affect cultural resources.

Please note that use of the term cultural resources includes both archaeological sites and historical buildings and/or structures. The review for possible historic-era building/structures, however, was limited to references currently in our office and should not be considered comprehensive.

Project Description: The proposed project entails approval of a Parcel Map on APN 011-015-16. The parcel is proposed to be divided into two parcels ranging in size from approximately 5.98 to 9.75 acres, served by onsite sewage disposal systems and well(s).

Previous Studies:

XX Study #S-00394 (Fredrickson 1976), covering approximately 100% of the proposed project area, identified no <u>cultural resources</u> (see recommendations below).

Archaeological and Native American Resources Recommendations:

_XX Based on an evaluation of the environmental setting and features associated with known sites, Native American resources in this part of Lake County have been found near areas populated by oak and buckeye, as well as near a variety of plant and animal resources. Sites are also found near watercourses and bodies of water. The proposed project area is located on a ridge in a wooded area. The project area is situated approximately 0.25 miles from Cole Creek. Given the similarity of one or more of these environmental factors, there is a moderate potential for unrecorded Native American resources in the proposed project area.

Due to the passage of time since the previous survey (Fredrickson 1976) and the changes in archaeological theory and method since that time, we recommend that a qualified archaeologist conduct further archival and field study for the entire project area to identify any unrecorded archaeological resources.

Built Environment Recommendations:

XX The 1943 and 1944 USGS Kelseyville 15' quads depict a building in the proposed project area. Since the Office of Historic Preservation has determined that any building or structure 45 years or older may be of historical value, it is recommended that prior to commencement of project activities, a qualified professional familiar with the architecture and history of Lake County conduct a formal CEQA evaluation.
