

Records at this office were reviewed to determine if this project could adversely affect cultural resources.

Please note that use of the term cultural resources includes both archaeological sites and historical buildings and/or structures.

The review for possible historic-era building/structures, however, was limited to references currently in our office and should not be considered comprehensive.

Previous Studies:

XX Study # 4973 (Parker 1982), covering approximately 100% of the proposed project area, identified no cultural resources (see recommendation below).

Archaeological and Native American Resources Recommendations:

XX Based on an evaluation of the environmental setting and features associated with known sites, Native American resources in this part of Lake County have been found all around the edge of Clear Lake, as well as inland on ridges, midslope benches, in valleys, near ecotones, and near intermittent and perennial watercourses. The proposed project area is located along the edge of Clear Lake at its northwestern end. Given the similarity of one or more of these environmental factors, there is a moderately high potential for unrecorded Native American resources in the proposed project area.

Due to the passage of time since the previous survey (Parker 1982) and the changes in archaeological theory and method since that time, we recommend a qualified archaeologist conduct further archival and field study for the entire project area to identify cultural resources.
