Re: Emergency Diversion and Use Agreement for the Geysers Project

Dear Ms. Sicke:

Due to anticipated water shortage conditions, I understand that the operators of the Geysers Project in Lake County have requested an Emergency Diversion and Use Agreement with Yolo County Flood Control and Water Conservation District (YCFCWCD). The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate diversion and use of up to 250 acre-feet of water from Clear Lake in May and June 2021 that is required for protection and operation of the Geysers Project facilities due to drought conditions and a pipeline outage affecting the Geysers Project water supplies.

Lake County has no objection to the proposed arrangement with the Geysers Project and further agrees that the emergency diversion and use of water by the operators of the Geysers Project in May and June 2021 shall be deemed a municipal use of water within Lake County, and not withdrawal of water by YCFCWCD for use in Yolo County, as defined in the Solano Decree.
