



The Middle Creek Flood Damage Reduction and Ecosystem Restoration Project (Project) will eliminate flood risk to 18 residential structures, numerous outbuildings and approximately 1,650 acres of agricultrual land and will restore damaged habitat and the water quality of the Clear Lake watershed.


Middle Creek Project: Goals & Objectives



The **Scotts Creek** and **Middle Creek** watersheds make up 50% of the Clear Lake watershed

These two watersheds provide 57% of the inflow and 71% of the phosphorus loading into Clear Lake



The Middle Creek Flood Damage Reduction and Ecosystem Restoration Project (Projec will eliminate flood risk to 18 residential structures, numerous outbuildings and approximately 1,650 acres of agricultural land and will restore damaged habitat and the water quality of the Clear Lake watershed.
