Amendment No. 1 AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF LAKE AND REDWOOD COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC. FOR THE MHSA TRANSITIONAL AGE YOUTH (TAY) DROP-IN CENTER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22

This Amendment No. 1 to Agreement is made and entered into this 1st day of July, 2021 by and between the County of Lake, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County") and Redwood Community Services, Inc. for the Transitional Age Youth (TAY) Drop-In Center, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor," collectively referred to as the "parties."

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the parties hereto have entered into an Agreement dated July 1, 2021 under which Contractor will provide specialized mental health services to eligible residents of County; and

WHEREAS, the parties agreed to amend that Agreement to reflect an increase to the contract maximum.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree to the following amendment to the Agreement:

3. <u>COMPENSATION</u>. Contractor has been selected by County to provide the services described hereunder in Exhibit A, titled, "Scope of Services". Compensation to Contractor previously listed as not to exceed Ninety Six Thousand Dollars (\$96,000.00) shall now read Two Hundred Sixty One Thousand Dollars (\$261,000).

The Parties agree that all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
