

**Amendment No. 1 AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY OF LAKE AND  
REDWOOD COMMUNITY SERVICES, INC. FOR THE MHSA  
TRANSITIONAL AGE YOUTH (TAY) DROP-IN CENTER  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-22**

This Amendment No. 1 to Agreement is made and entered into this 1st day of July, 2021 by and between the County of Lake, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County") and Redwood Community Services, Inc. for the Transitional Age Youth (TAY) Drop-In Center, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor," collectively referred to as the "parties."

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the parties hereto have entered into an Agreement dated July 1, 2021 under which Contractor will provide specialized mental health services to eligible residents of County; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties agreed to amend that Agreement to reflect an increase to the contract maximum.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the parties hereby agree to the following amendment to the Agreement:

**3. COMPENSATION**. Contractor has been selected by County to provide the services described hereunder in **Exhibit A**, titled, "**Scope of Services**". **Compensation to Contractor previously listed as not to exceed Ninety Six Thousand Dollars (\$96,000.00) shall now read Two Hundred Sixty One Thousand Dollars (\$261,000).**

The Parties agree that all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.


