PROCLAMATION

Commending Jeff Rein for his 30 Years of Service to the County of Lake

- WHEREAS,** Jeff Rein began his career with the County of Lake on March 18, 1991, as an Accounting Technician in the Sheriff's Jail Division; and
- WHEREAS,** on November 2, 1993, Jeff was promoted to Administrative Analyst in the County Administrative Office where he successfully performed a wide variety of assignments, including assisting with the County's annual budget preparation, serving as liaison to several County departments and preparing staff reports and presentations for the Board of Supervisors and others; and
- WHEREAS,** on July 1, 1999, Jeff's position was reclassified and he was promoted to Deputy County Administrative Officer and continued distinguishing himself for his capabilities relative to County financial matters, including assuming the lead role in refinancing of several assessment district bonds, which resulted in a significant savings to the taxpayers and to the water & sewer ratepayers of Lake County, and he also assumed lead staff responsibility for administration of the Risk Management Division after reorganization of Risk Management into a division of the Administrative Office; and
- WHEREAS,** on January 2, 2013, Jeff transferred to the Public Services Department where he served as Deputy Public Services Director, responsible for planning and direction of many of the department's mandates and special projects; and
- WHEREAS,** in 2015, after the devastating Valley Fire, Jeff stepped up as a Disaster Service Worker to coordinate with local, state, and federal representatives to manage the extraordinary volume of donations the County had received on behalf of wildfire survivors; and
- WHEREAS,** also in 2015, Jeff returned to the Administrative Office where he was later promoted to Chief Deputy County Administrative Officer, again having an instrumental role in budget and finance, and in the training, transition and success of leadership staff; and
- WHEREAS,** on September 1, 2018, Jeff transferred to the office of the County Counsel as Risk Manager where he has shown an unerring ability to recognize, understand, and apply the principles of risk assessment to effectively balance the need to reduce potential liabilities while still advancing the goals of the County in moving projects forward; and
- WHEREAS,** Jeff has been a loyal, steadfast employee, able to move effortlessly among various County departments, sharing his fiscal expertise and common-sense approach to solving many issues facing County government; and
- WHEREAS,** throughout the course of his work, Jeff has established many meaningful, professional relationships that have served the County well through the years, with County employees, representatives of local, state and federal governments; and
- WHEREAS,** after more than 30 years of proud public service, Jeff Rein will retire from the County of Lake at the close of Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that on behalf of the Lake County Board of Supervisors, Jeff Rein is commended for his years of service to Lake County and wished happiness in his retirement.
