

Dear Victoria Kim,

Records at this office were reviewed to determine if this project could adversely affect cultural resources. Please note that use of the term cultural resources includes both archaeological sites and historical buildings and/or structures. The review for possible historic-era building/structures, however, was limited to references currently in our office and should not be considered comprehensive.

Project Description: approval of a Major Use Permit to allow the following:

- 20,000 SF. outdoor canopy area
- 64 SF. surveillance storage
- (2) drying sheds (192 SF. each /384 SF. in total)
- (1) ADA restroom (64 SF.)
- (1) fertilizer storage shed (96 SF.)
- Existing (1) fertilizer storage shed
- The property is accessed from Schuette Road.

Previous Studies:

XX This office has record of four previous studies that cover portions of the proposed project area. Study # 145 (Keesling and French 1975) was a large study that included the project area within its research, but did not include any field survey. Study # 10992 (Flaherty 1989) covered approximately 50% of the proposed project area. Study # 52516a (Parker 2020), included with the project review request, covered 100% of the proposed project area. And Study # 52516 (Parker 2019), covered approximately 50% of the proposed project area. These studies identified no cultural resources. Further study for cultural resources is not recommended at this time.

Archaeological and Native American Resources Recommendations:

XX We recommend the lead agency contact the local Native American tribe(s) regarding traditional, cultural, and religious heritage values. For a complete listing of tribes in the vicinity of the project, please contact the Native American Heritage Commission at 916/373-3710.

XX Due to the negative findings of the most recent previous surveys (Parker 2020 and 2019) that included the proposed project areas, no further study for archaeological resources is recommended at this time. If archaeological resources are encountered during the project, work in the immediate vicinity of the finds should be halted until a qualified archaeologist has evaluated the situation.

Built Environment Recommendations:

XX Since the Office of Historic Preservation has determined that any building or structure 45 years or older may be of historical value, if the project area contains such properties, it is recommended that prior to commencement of project activities, a qualified professional familiar with the architecture and history of Lake County conduct a formal CEQA evaluation.

Due to processing delays and other factors, not all of the historical resource reports and resource records that have been submitted to the Office of Historic Preservation are available via this records search. Additional information may be available through the federal, state, and local agencies that produced or paid for historical resource management work in the search area. Additionally, Native American tribes have historical resource information not in the California Historical Resources Information System (CHRIS) Inventory, and you should contact the California Native American Heritage Commission for information on local/regional tribal contacts.

The California Office of Historic Preservation (OHP) contracts with the California Historical Resources Information System's (CHRIS) regional Information Centers (ICs) to maintain information in the CHRIS inventory and make it available to local, state, and federal agencies, cultural resource professionals, Native American tribes, researchers, and the public. Recommendations made by IC coordinators or their staff regarding the interpretation and application of this information are advisory only. Such recommendations do not necessarily represent the evaluation or opinion of the State Historic Preservation Officer in carrying out the OHP's regulatory authority under federal and state law.
