Record ID	Record ID	Plain Text	The identification number issued by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Licensing and Certification Section (LCS), for licensed facilities or certified programs. The last digit tells if the facility/ program is a nonprofit (N) or profit (P) entity.
Type of Application	Type of Program	Plain Text	The type of application identifies if the program is licensed only, certified only, or a combined licensed and certified program.
Legal Name	Legal Name	Plain Text	The legal name of the entity having the authority and responsibility for the operation of the facility or program.
Program Name	Program Name	Plain Text	The facility/program name.
Facility Address	Facility Address	Plain Text	The facility/ program address. The location where services are provided.
Facility Address2	Facility Address2	Plain Text	Secondary facility/ program Address information
Additional Facility Locations	Additional Facility Locations	Plain Text	Additional facility/ program addresses. Additional locations where services are provided.
Facility City	Facility City	Plain Text	Name of the city where the facility/ program is located.

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Service Type	Service Type	Plain Text	<p>Indicates if the facility/program is:</p> <p>RES - Indicates facility licensed by the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP), the licensing authority for 24-hour residential nonmedical alcoholism or drug abuse recovery or treatment facilities serving adults.</p> <p>NON - Indicates a nonresidential program which has voluntarily applied to ADP for alcohol and/ or drug certification.</p> <p>DETOX - Indicates a free standing, 24-hour nonmedical detoxification facility licensed by ADP.</p> <p>RES-DETOX - Indicates a facility licensed by ADP to provide 24-hour residential nonmedical alcohol and/or drug recovery, treatment, and detoxification services for adults. ☐</p> <p>DHS - Indicates licensure by the Department of Health Services, the licensing authority for medical alcohol and drug recovery or treatment facilities whose programs are certified by ADP. Typically, these are Chemical Dependency Recovery Hospitals.</p> <p>DSS - Indicates licensure by the Department of Social Services, the licensing authority for residential facilities for individuals in need of care and supervision whose programs are certified by ADP. Typically, these are group homes.</p> <p>COR - Indicates the facility is under the jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections (locked facility) whose program is certified by ADP.</p>
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Resident Capacity	Resident Capacity	Number	Indicates the maximum number of residents authorized by ADP to receive recovery, treatment, or detoxification services at any one time in the residential facility. <i>(The resident capacity and total occupancy are only indicated for licensed residential facilities. Certified nonresidential facilities show "0" as the resident capacity and total occupancy.)</i>
Total Occupancy	Total Occupancy	Number	Designates the maximum number of residential facility participants plus any dependent children, staff, or volunteers who may be housed in the facility. This occupancy is approved by the State or local fire authority.
Expiration Date	Expiration Date	Number	Expiration date of the facility's current license and/or certification.
Target Population	Target Population	Plain Text	Describes the targeted population of the facility or program. 1.1 – Co-Ed 1.2 – Men Only 1.3 - Women Only 1.4 - Women/Children 1.5 – Youth/Adolescents 1.7 – Families 1.8 – Dual Diagnosis 1.9 – Co-Ed/Children 1.10 – Co-Ed/Youth 1.11 – Men/Youth 1.12 – Women/Youth 1.13 – Co-Ed/Child/Dual 1.14 – Women/Child/Dual
