I, MARIA VALADEZ, Registrar of Voters, do hereby certify that, in pursuance of the provisions of Division 15, Chapter 4, Article 5 (commencing with Section 15360) of the Elections Code, State of California, I conducted the 1% public manual tally of randomly selected precincts for the September 14, 2021 Statewide Special Election commencing and ending on Tuesday, September 28, 2021; and the following random voting precincts were selected for the 1% manual tally: VBM-431 and VBM-432 along with Seventh-Day Adventist Church polling place totals for 431 and 432 voting precincts; VBM-541; VBM-581; and, Mail Ballot Precinct 117. The findings of the Canvassing Board, consisting of four (4) members, found that the Hart Verity Voting System tabulated the ballots correctly and the Canvassing Board did not find any discrepancies between the machine count and the manual tally.

Following the completion of the 1% public manual tally and counting all of the remaining vote-by-mail ballots, duplicated ballots, approved office provisional/conditional ballots, and approved polls provisional/conditional ballots; I do hereby certify that, in pursuance of the provisions of Division 15, Chapter 4, Article 1 (commencing with Section 15300) of the Elections Code, I did canvass the returns of the votes cast for the Recall of Governor ballot question and the candidates to succeed the Governor if recalled; and, I do hereby certify that the Statement of Votes Cast, to which this certification is attached, shows the total number of votes cast in each of the respective voting precincts therein, and that the totals of the respective columns and the totals as shown for the ballot question and the candidates are full, true and correct.
