Executive Summary:

Every day, millions of people face stigma related to mental illness, causing many to face their mental health challenges for years without help. Each May, Mental Health Matters Month provides the opportunity for everyone to come together to illuminate mental health awareness to stop the stigma. Bringing forth this awareness is crucial to helping people reach out for the assistance they deserve.

WHEREAS, mental health challenges are one of the most common health conditions in California, affecting one out of seven adults, and one out of fourteen youth, and impacting both the person experiencing mental health challenges and those persons who care and love the person facing the challenge; and

WHEREAS, one out of every twenty-six Californian's with a serious mental illness have difficulty functioning in everyday life and if left untreated, have life expectancies 25 years shorter than the general population; and

WHEREAS, every day, millions of people face stigma related to mental health and may feel isolated and alone, going years before receiving any help; and

WHEREAS, recovery can and does happen, and all Californians should know that support and help is available regardless of any individual's situation; and
