Executive Summary:

The Lease Agreement with Pauline Usher Revocable Trust is for storage space located in Lower Lake, which has been utilized by the Department of Social Services since 1998. This Second Amendment will extend the term of the Lease by 3 years for an end date of June 30, 2027. There are no other changes included within this Amendment.

The Department of Social Services maintains leases for all buildings it occupies and cannot evaluate purchasing an office location, or relocating as a possible long-term cost saving alternative due to the consequential disruption a relocation would pose for the community, insufficient office space availability in the County, and the projected fiscal impact to the Department.
