EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

This item is being submitted as an “extra” agenda item. The justification for this request to consider an item not on the posted agenda is as follows:

- The need to take action came to my attention subsequent to the posting of the current agenda.

On October 6, 2019, staff was alerted by PG&E of an impending Public Safety Power Shutoff event expected to impact Lake County starting in the early morning hours of October 9 and continuing until mid-day on October 10.
