Subject: A) Approve Travel of Over 1,500 Miles for Lake County District 2 Supervisor to Attend the NACo Annual Conference in Tampa, Florida from July 11, 2024 through July 15, 2024; and B) Approve of Registering District 2 Supervisor as the Voting Delegate for the NACo 2024 Annual Business Meeting

Executive Summary:

A) The annual NACo conference will take place this year in Tampa, Florida from 7/12-7/15. During the conference, not only will I be learning about federal programs that can benefit the County of Lake, but I will also be attending my two policy groups that I am a member of. I am a current member of the NACo Health Policy Steering Committee and the newly reformed Economic Mobility Leadership Advisory Council which also includes the Rural Leaders for Economic Mobility.

Networking is always a key component to any and all conferences and I intend to follow up with a wide variety of Commissioners, Judges, and Supervisors from across the nation with whom I've been building relationships with as we discuss similar issues occurring in the communities we serve.

I am also seeking a Vice-Chair membership on the NACo Health Policy Steering Committee and that announcement will be made at the annual meeting. With our health metrics where they stand today in Lake County, I find it critical to position our Board in the conversations that could lead to greater

health outcomes in our future.
