Executive Summary:

The Lake County Watershed Protection District (District) is tasked with keeping the waters of Clear Lake free for navigation, recreation, and fisheries. As such, the District actively removes hazards from Clear Lake. While the District is currently contracted with a towing company to remove such hazards, larger and inaccessible items are difficult for current staff and contractors to abate. To address this gap in hazard removal on Clear Lake, the District desires to enter into an agreement with 360 Junk Removal & Hauling.

The County of Lake Community Development Department (CDD) issued RFQ 22-27 Abatement on June 13th 2022. After reviewing all proposals and following the County purchasing procedures, CDD
