EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

A wildland fire known as the Kincaid Fire began in Sonoma County on October 26, 2019 forcing area-wide evacuations, destroying multiple structures and threatening Lake County.

In addition, between October 9, 2019 and October 29, 2019, repeated and compounding PSPS events have been imposed by PG&E, on the citizens of Lake County, disrupting services and creating extreme hardships for all. As a result of the occurrence of the Kincaid Fire, and repeated PSPS events, a local emergency was proclaimed by the Lake County Sheriff/Director of Emergency Services Brian Martin on October 29, 2019.

The Board of Supervisors must confirm the existence of a local emergency within seven (7) days of that date.
