**Executive Summary:** The current County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan includes a task of creating Lake County's first Climate Adaptation Plan (CAP). A CAP identifies focus areas and includes problem statements based on the results of the Vulnerability Assessment to help the County develop adaptation strategies.

PlaceWorks is currently under contract for planning services for the Local Area Plans and General Plan updates. Included in that project is the Climate Vulnerability Assessment, as part of the Safety Element Update. PlaceWorks possesses the resources to add the CAP to the Scope of Work.

The funds to prepare the CAP are included in the State's Adaptation Planning Grant Program (APGP) to support several initiatives under the umbrella of the Planning for an Equitable Climate-Safe Lake
