Executive Summary: (include fiscal and staffing impact narrative):

On September 10, 2019 the Board of Supervisors approved the creation of the Industrial Hemp Ad Hoc Committee in order to make recommendations for Industrial Hemp Regulations. On September 24, 2019 the committee made up of Supervisors, industry representatives, the Lake County Farm Bureau, and staff was finalized and the meetings began on October 11, 2019.

The ad hoc committee has met every two weeks, mostly, to ensure that regulations could be recommended timely prior to the new season starting in 2020. Today, before your board is the resolution that would bring these regulations, in a form of a zoning permit, to the Lake County Planning Commission on February 27, 2020 for their consideration.

A zoning permit is a ministerial process where applicants can approach Community Development, ensure that their property meets the requirements and that they have received all necessary permits, such as grading permits, prior to finalizing the process with the Ag Department. Without an approved
