Response by Hub Group, Incorporated, of Oak Park, IL

Executive Summary: (include fiscal and staffing impact narrative):

With jurisdictions around the country preparing for a potential surge in confirmed COVID-19 cases, some private companies are making equipment and supplies available to be repurposed for local disaster response.

The Lake County Sheriff's Office was recently informed of an opportunity to acquire a refrigerated trailer from Hub Group, Incorporated, of Oak Park, Illinois. A limited number of trailers were made available, and Hub Group's Senior Vice President, Ivan S. Zenovic, notified the Office of Emergency Services Lake County be receiving one.

We greatly appreciate the Hub Group's extraordinary generosity, and your Board's acceptance of this donation, valued at \$17,200, will enhance the Lake County Sheriff-Coroner's capacity to respond in the event of a surge in COVID-19 activity in the coming weeks.
