**Executive Summary:** The Sheriff's Department requests approval to exceed the 900 hour extra help limit on the following employees. Jim Adams has been working on several specialized projects and we would like to request he be authorized to work an additional 60 hours. He will not exceed 960 total hours in this fiscal year.
