### **Executive Summary:**

I would like to ask the Board to adopt the attached resolution approving an Industrial Hemp resolution agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture. It reimburses the County for registering hemp growers and seed breeders, enforcing all laws and regulations, public outreach, training staff, reimbursement for mileage and supplies pertaining to industrial hemp. There are currently 48 hemp registrants in the County of Lake. The agreement would reimburse the County up to \$70,911 for the activities listed above. This agreement goes from April 30, 2019 through June 30, 2020. Most of this funding will be used for previously conducted work, but some funding will still be available for use until June 30, 2020. This is unanticipated revenue and will need Board of Supervisors approval to be spent.
