**Executive Summary:** North American Mental Health Services will provide psychiatric medication evaluations and medication management for Lake County Behavioral Health Services (LCBHS) clients. As LCBHS does not have a psychiatrist on staff at this time, NAMHS TelePsychiatry services are a necessary component in providing overall mental health care for Lake County Medi-Cal beneficiaries. In addition, NAMHS will provide clinical supervision of LCBH's Physician Assistant. As LCBHS has had a successful working relationship with NAMHS and it is in the best interest to continue this working relationship, LCBHS is requesting to waive the formal bidding process,
