Executive Summary: (include fiscal and staffing impact narrative):

The attached Resolutions are being presented to the Board of Supervisors at this time at the request of the Cobb Area County Water District (District). The District is requesting your adoption of the Resolutions for the purpose of installing larger water mains, within the roadways, to provide increased water flow and necessary fire hydrants for fire protection for the people of the Mount Hannah Subdivisions No. 2 and No. 3 community. These roadways will not be County maintained.

The recording of Mount Hannah No. 2 Subdivision on April 22, 1952, included an offer to dedicate a roadway known as Road No. 1 aka Carrie Lane for public use. While the County Board of Supervisors approved the Subdivision Map, it rejected the offer of dedication of the roadway for public use.
