**Executive Summary:** (include fiscal and staffing impact narrative):

On March 15, 2021, the Governor's Office of Business and Economic Development (GO-Biz) announced its intent to award \$888,173.18 Type II Funding grant, with \$844,138.18 available for program use, to Lake County to implement a Cannabis Local Equity Program. In order to complete, the grant agreement Go-Biz requires a slightly modified version of the resolution previously adopted by your Board.

Once this funding is made available, the County will be able to implement selected portions of the Local Equity Plan. The overall amount of funding made available by the State for these programs was approximately 50% less than last year, so given the size of the award and the grant requirements the authorized budget is allocated as follows:
